Cross-departmental support is a general expectation of all USAV employees. The position is located in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

Summary of Duties and Responsibilities include but are not necessarily limited to:

- Draft, develop and execute strategic marketing campaigns for USA Volleyball events and programs.
 - Manage project timelines and deliverables.
 - Communicate with internal and external stakeholders to deliver assets and establish deadlines.
 - Brief creative team for production of written, graphic and video content.
 - Prepare and analyze campaign reports, survey feedback and key performance metrics.
- Responsible for supporting USA Volleyball Foundation marketing and supporting fundraising initiatives.
- Collaborate with USA Volleyball Foundation Board to support alumni initiatives.
- Write copy to market, promote and build engagement around the athletes, events, USA Volleyball and the sport of volleyball.
