National Officials Development Program (NODP) Overview

The **MISSON** of the National Officials Development Program (NODP) is to identify, recruit, and accelerate the development of high-potential referees for the purpose of strengthening our Regions and our National and International referee programs to achieve sustained excellence.

NODP is the USAV Training and International evaluation program for officials pursuing National-level and International certifications. The efforts of NODP Referee Coaches are focused on helping our officials be the best they can be and assisting the Officials Development Team in placing officials in USAV-owned Qualifiers and National Championship events where they are exposed to the highest level of play.

Officials in attendance at designated USAV-owned Qualifiers and National Championships are eligible to receive referee coaching, as well as work with other top-level referees. This includes evaluations conducted by a head official at USAV-owned Qualifiers and National Championships.

NODP Referee Coach Reviews use a targeted evaluation form comprised of four sections that define the acronym "RISE":

REFLECT - Events/situations from the match where philosophical and/or preferred techniques may be used for reflection by the referee during the debrief and applied in future matches.

IMPLEMENT – An indication of the referee's professionalism, knowledge of the rules, ability to control the match and how the referee implemented these skills while conducting the match.

SET GOALS – Referees should continuously be setting goals for themselves. This section identifies current areas of strength as well as opportunities for improvement.

EVALUATE – For those pursuing a Nationallevel official, the expected standard for the evaluated categories in this section is "Good" for all matches. The referee's performance in that particular match dictates whether the evaluation moves to one side or the other of column 3.

National Officials Development Program (NODP)

Purpose:

The NODP Program provides feedback and coaching to current Provisional and Regional Referees that will lead to a stronger foundation of officiating. Junior National and National officials will receive feedback and coaching to build a stronger foundation, for possible certification and advancement.

Criteria:

- NODP Officials must register with USA Volleyball, complete SafeSport Training, pass a background screen, and be in good standing with their USA Volleyball Region.
- NODP referee coaching may take place at any USA Volleyball-owned event.
- NODP referee coaching evaluations will be both as an R1 and R2.
- NODP referee coaches will work directly with NODP candidates providing on court feedback while officiating.

Age Limits:

- National Referee must be maximum age of 40 upon entering the program.
- Junior National Referee must be maximum age of 38 upon entering the program.
- Regional and Provisional Referee must be maximum age of 36 upon entering the program.

Process:

- Must be invited to the program by The USAV Officials Development Department—a maximum of 40 individuals will be invited.
- Invited referees submit an online application.
- A USAV Provisional, Regional, Junior National, and National NODP referee will be given priority for coaching and mentoring, when possible, as both a 1st and 2nd referee at USA Volleyball-owned events they attend.
 - The referee coach or head official will conduct a formal debrief as soon as possible depending on the availability of the referee and the coach.
 - The NODP referee mentors will work directly with the NODP candidates during the match and provide an after-match debrief when possible.
- All coaching and mentoring are viewed as growth opportunities.
- For Junior National/National certification: Once an NODP official has been approved by the NODP coaches' committee, they will be invited to the next certification event (GJNC 18s or GJNC 14s-17s).

Fees:

- Registration fee of \$300 when entering the program. A maximum of 10 match fees when receiving coaching at USAV-owned events.

 - Boys Junior National Championship Regionals, Junior Nationals, and Nationals
