



USA Volleyball Junior National Referee Candidate Application Information & Online Course Instructions 2024-2025 Season

1. You must be in good standing in your region from the time of application through the conclusion of the Junior National Referee Candidate Program. A current USAV background screen, SafeSport training, and HIROS Training must be completed at the time of application. A Junior National referee candidate with less than a full season as a Regional referee will not be accepted.
2. Candidates must register in SportsEngine for the Junior National Referee Candidate Program and pay the \$400 application fee by **April 1, 2025 at 11:59 PM Pacific Time**.
3. The Junior National Candidate application material must be uploaded into the USA Volleyball Academy by **Tuesday April 1, 2025 at 11:59 PM Pacific Time**. PDF format is no longer required.
 - a) Electronic signatures (candidate, Referees' Chair, and Commissioner) are acceptable.
 - b) Candidates must attend, as a full-time referee without conflict, a minimum of two USAV National Qualifier and one USAV National Championship, or one USAV National Qualifier and two USAV National Championships or three USAV National Championships (GJNC 11-13 or GJNC 14-17) during the officiating activities time frame.
 - c) Candidates must demonstrate second referee (R2) proficiency and should volunteer to work as a second referee both within and outside the region when appropriate.
 - d) Priority will be given to candidates that attend USA Volleyball Junior National Candidate Camps. Camper numbers may vary based on referee coach availability.
 - Camp 1: 2024 Girls Junior National Candidate Camp, July 8 – July 11, 2024, in Las Vegas, NV – 40 campers – (completed).
 - Camp 2: 2025 Sunshine Junior National Candidate Camp, February 22- 24, 2025, in Orlando, FL – 14 campers
 - Camp 3: 2025 Salt Lake City Showdown Junior National Candidate Camp, April 11-13, 2025, in Salt Lake City, UT – 20 campers
 - e) Priority will be given to candidates, who officiate as a full-time referee without conflict, at USA Volleyball events, USA Volleyball National Qualifiers, and USA Volleyball National Championships within the activity period (March 28, 2023 – April 1, 2025).
 - f) Please provide the Officiating Activities Report with your application.
 - g) Please provide three (3) Letters of Recommendation
 - h) Please include a brief letter - "Why I want to be a Junior National Referee" - with your application.
 - i) Please provide a headshot photo.
 - j) Notification of acceptance will be no later than **April 15, 2025**. Applicants not accepted as a candidate, will receive a refund within two weeks.
4. Failure to meet any of the above listed deadlines or criteria may result in non-acceptance to the Junior National Referee Candidacy Program this season.
5. A qualified candidate must be capable of filling out and uploading an application into the USA Volleyball Academy, completing an accurate and detailed activity report, submitting a letter of "why I want to be a candidate", and securing three letters of recommendation.
6. You must demonstrate scoring proficiency using national scoring procedures during the evaluation process by: 1) completing a scoring proficiency quiz, and 2) serving as the scorer during a match.
7. Candidates must register for the event in AES. Applicants who are not selected as candidates are still encouraged to attend the event as a paid referee.

8. The 2025 Girls' JNC will be held in Dallas, Texas at the Kay Bailey Hutchinson Convention Center, June 25 - July 3. All candidates are required to attend the candidates' meeting on **Sunday, June 29, at 7:00 PM** at the playing venue. You must be available with no schedule conflicts during the four-day program from **June 30 – July 3**. Candidates may schedule departure from the convention center any time after 7:00 PM on July 3 (this is mandatory). NOTE: Candidates will not be paid for evaluation matches but will be paid for any non-evaluation matches during the candidate program (paid matches are not guaranteed).
9. You may request event housing, but you will be responsible for paying one-half of the room cost during the Junior National Candidate Program. Alternatively, you may secure your own hotel accommodations.
 - a) When you register for the tournament, you will have the option to request event housing.
 - b) If you utilize event housing during your candidacy, you must pay for your hotel room **in advance** by the deadline of April 1, 2025.

Junior National Referee Candidate Online Course

Applicants for Junior National Referee certification are required to complete the online Junior National Referee Candidate Course by **April 1, 2025, 11:59 PM Pacific Time**, along with all other requirements associated with candidacy. Failure to complete this course by the deadline will result in non-acceptance as a Junior National Referee candidate.

For applicants who have already taken the modules or exams for your region requirements, your records will be verified in the USA Volleyball Academy to confirm completion.

Applicants must complete all available and current USA Volleyball Officials Academy National Clinics by **April 1, 2025, 11:59 PM Pacific Time**.

Instructions for Completing the Junior National Referee Candidate Course

1. The coursework will be added to your USAV Academy within a week of your registration. Log into the USAV Academy from your SportsEngine account

Junior National Referee Candidate Checklist

To apply and be considered as a candidate for USAV Junior National Referee certification, an applicant must complete and submit the following no later than **April 1, 2025, 11:59 PM Pacific Time**:

- Current USA Volleyball Membership
- Current USAV background screen, SafeSport training, and HIROS Harassment Training must be completed at time of application
- Candidates must register in SportsEngine for the Junior National Referee Candidate Program and pay the \$400 application fee
- The Junior National Candidate application material must be uploaded into the USA Volleyball Academy
 - Completed Application Data Sheet, typed (electronic signatures accepted)
 - Completed Officiating Activities Summary (**March 28, 2023 – April 1, 2025**), typed, priority will be given to candidates that attend USA Volleyball events, USA Volleyball Candidate Camps, USA Volleyball National Qualifiers, and USA Volleyball National Championships
 - Candidates must attend, as a full-time referee without conflict, a minimum of two USAV National Qualifier and one USAV National Championship, or one USAV National Qualifier and two USAV National Championships or three USAV National Championships (GJNC 11-13 or GJNC 14-17) during the officiating activities time frame.
 - “Why I want to be a Junior National Referee” Letter
 - Three (3) Letters of Recommendation
 - Headshot of candidate
