

USA Volleyball Junior National Referee Candidate Camp Instructions 2024-2025 Season

- 1. Applicants must be in good standing in their region from the time of application through the conclusion of the Junior National Referee Camp. A current USAV background screen, SafeSport training, and HIROS Training must be completed at the time of application. A Junior National referee camper must be certified as a Regional referee for a minimum of one full season (or will have completed one full season prior to applying as a Junior National Candidate). Recommended Junior National Referee Candidates will be selected first, non-recommended Junior National Campers will be selected if there is availability.
- 2. Candidates must register in SportsEngine for the Junior National Referee Candidate Camps and pay the camp fee by the deadlines below.
 - Camp 1: 2025 Sunshine Junior National Candidate Camp, February 22- 24, 2025, in Orlando, FL
 \$300 fee Deadline January 8, 2025 at 11:59 PM PST
 - Camp 2: 2025 Salt Lake City Showdown Junior National Candidate Camp, April 11-13, 2025, in Salt Lake City, UT
 \$300 fee Deadline February 26, 2025 at 11:59 PM PST
 - Camp 3: 2025 Girls Junior National Championship 14-17s Junior National Candidate Camp, June 25-28, 2025, in Dallas, TX; \$400 fee Deadline April 23, 2025 at 11:59 PM PST
- The Junior National Referee Candidate Camp application material must be uploaded into the USA Volleyball Academy by the respective camp deadlines listed above.
 - a) Junior National Candidate Camp Recommendation Form (not required unless recommended for candidacy by your Region's Officials Chair)
 - b) Please provide a headshot photo.
 - c) Notification of acceptance to camps will be no later than:
 - Camp 1: January 10, 2025
 - Camp 2: February 28, 2025
 - Camp 3: May 7, 2025
 - d) Applicants not accepted as a camper will receive a refund within two weeks of notification date.
- 4. Failure to meet any of the above-listed criteria, deadlines, or requirements may result in non-acceptance to a Junior National Referee Camp this season.
- 5. A qualified applicant must be capable of filling out and uploading the Junior National Candidate Recommendation form and a headshot photo into the USA Volleyball Academy.
- 6. Campers must register for the event in AES.
- 7. Campers may request camp housing but will be responsible for paying one-half of the room cost during the Junior National Candidate Camp. Alternatively, campers may secure their own hotel accommodations.
 - a) When you register for the camp, you will have the option to request camp housing.
 - b) If you utilize camp housing during your camp, you must pay for your hotel room in advance by the deadline:
 - Sunshine Classic Qualifier Camp February 22 February 24, 2025 Orlando, FL January 8, 2025
 - Salt Lake City Showdown Qualifier Camp April 11-13, 2025 Salt Lake City, UT February 26, 2025
 - Girls Junior National Championship 14-17s Camp June 25-28, 2025 Dallas, TX– April 23, 2025

Junior National Referee Camper Required Online Course

Applicants for Junior National Referee Candidate Camps are required to complete the online Junior National Referee Camper Training Course by **the respective dates listed**, along with uploading a headshot and the Junior National Candidate Recommendation Form (if applicable). Failure to complete this course by the deadline may result in non-acceptance as a camper.

For applicants who have already taken the modules or exams for your region or Junior National Candidate requirements, your coursework will automatically be populated and verified in the USA Volleyball Academy to confirm completion.

Instructions for Completing the Junior National Referee Camper Training Course

- The coursework will be added to your USAV Academy within a week of your registration. Log into the USAV Academy from your SportsEngine account
